
Look! He is coming with the clouds;

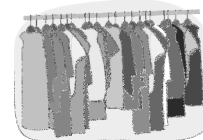
