Elf also undertook the role of Deanery Training Officer and arranged and led many courses. She was also a great friend to all the other teams in the Deanery, helping them as and when she could. Elf's funeral will be held in St Mary's Beaminster on Monday 28th November at 2.00 pm, she will spend the night before in Church. Thanks to Jo and the babies and toddler group members for agreeing to cancel that morning so that this can take place.
